Bestwest Care's CPR course is a unit of competency which provides the skills and knowledge required to perform CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) . This unit is also a component of HLTAID003 Provide First Aid.

The Australian Resuscitation Council recommends that CPR is refreshed on an annual basis.

PERFORM CPR

The skills and knowledge described here relate specifically to performing Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and do not address other aspects of resuscitation, life support or first aid.

This course is suitable for the general public, learners, corporate clients, healthcare professionals, fitness professionals and teachers.

PRE-REQUISITES

There are no pre-requisites for this unit of competency.

INCLUDED IN THIS COURSE

- Hazard assessment/risk management
- Airway, breathing and responsiveness
- Safe manual handling techniques
- Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation
- Using an Automated External Defibrillator
- Incident reporting

IMPORTANT NOTE:

A nationally recognised First Aid qualification requires a level of physical capability to meet the performance evidence requirements. This relates to the ability to provide uninterrupted cardio pulmonary resuscitation on an adult manikin on the floor and an infant manikin on a firm surface over a period of 2 minutes, and respond to an emergency situation where there may be risk to life.

If a candidate is physically unable to meet the assessment requirements, ie cannot perform resuscitation to the required standards, a nationally recognized statement of attainment cannot be issued. In this instance a certificate of attendance will be issued to the candidate.

How is the course constructed? The course is run over 2 hours and includes both theory and practical assessments.

How often is the course run?

The course is run regularly.

What do I need to do to apply for a place in the course?

Complete an application form and full payment of fees.
