ABOUT THIS QUALIFICATION

This course consists of a 7 core units of competency plus specialized units to allow you to complete 3 different streams. There are 6 additional units of competency for each specialist stream.

These specialist streams are

- Ageing
- Disability
- Home and Community Care

You can choose one, two or all three streams.

We recommend that you complete these on a face to face basis in class but we recognise that people are busy and there are part time and flexible options available. Bestwest Care will work with the student to assist them to meet their goals.

Most of the units of competency are structured into clusters in order to reduce repetition and to enable the student to gain the maximum amount of practical experience before their work placement.

HOW DO YOU ENROL IN THE COURSE?

All applicants are required to attend a meeting with a member of our training staff. This ensures that each student is aware of the course structure and requirements and assists Bestwest Care to provide the best outcome for each individual person.

ACCEPTANCE OF ENROLMENTS

To be accepted into the course you will need:

- A current USI number - (Unique student identifier)
- To hold a clear current national police certificate
- To hold a working with children certificate
- Be able to participate in training in Australia
- To be reasonably fit and physically capable of performing the role
- Literacy and numeracy levels necessary for you to be able to perform in the role of a care worker
- Be able to attend and complete the classroom and practical components of the course



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How long is the course?

Full time the course runs for a minimum of 6 – 7 weeks. The first 2.5 weeks are training sessions conducted in a classroom setting.

This is followed by a minimum of 4 weeks practical experience in an aged care facility.

We try to arrange this practical work as soon as possible after the theory has been completed, and at a facility convenient for your needs, however due to the number of learners seeking placements delays may occasionally occur.

What if I have experience?

Bestwest Care recognizes prior learning. This will be discussed with you on enrolment with you prior to enrolment.

What if I have done some of the units previously?

If you have completed a relevant unit, you may be able to claim an exemption. The process will be explained to you on enrolment.
