COURSE STRUCTURE

There are 14 units of competency in this course.

The course is completed through a combination of attendance at training sessions, home study and practical workplace experience.

Some units of competency must be completed by in class attendance.

Assessment is through written work and by practical experience. A project to be completed throughout the course is a part of the assessment process.

The course is a mix of clustered and single units.

WHAT YOU WILL NEED TO ENROL

- Have a current national police certificate (only if requiring a work placement to be organised)
- Have a current working with children certificate (only if requiring a work placement to be organised)
- Have a current USI number (Unique student identifier)
- Be able to work and study in Australia
- To be reasonably fit and physically capable of performing the role
- Have literacy and numeracy levels necessary for the role
- Attend an enrolment meeting with a member of our training team

TRAINERS AND ASSESSORS

All Bestwest Care trainers have current Certificate IV Trainer & Assessment qualifications and relevant vocational competencies.
